a. Mtn bike:

- c. Welding is a struggle. Mid-October. After can test pumps. Steel pipe segments. Needs to be in culvert and segments welded together. Challenge finding welder. Chris Weets crewman for the well may come back to.
- d. Drainage: hill #6, lower parking lot, west perimeter trail
- e. Nordic workday need to trim back the connector trail which is getting narrow.
- f. Trying to source some old tractor tires to use for rope tows. Ken thought Don may have an idea.
- g. Plan for plowing and sanding the drive? Follow the approach from last year. Plan plow by Dominic and sanding by Keleny?
- h. Hill 6 water draining and collecting. Hanging pond on Dan Erdmans property. Ephemeral pond that fills up in spring and fall. Drains down Hill 6. Installed drain tile down Hill 6 to drain the pond. Alliant destroyed drain tile (did not know it was there). Now we have a spring flowing down the hill. Need to hand dig to find outlet of drain tile and reconnect. Working on a solution with Casey
- i. West Perimeter trail needs to be fixed (Jeremy project?)
- j. Parking space measurements office buildings: 9 ft wide. Retail/Grocery: 10 ft wide. Consider 9-½ ft wide slot to give room for people to get out with gear on.
- k. Do we have rope or wire to use to distinguish parking slots.
